

Privacy Policy

Ginkgo Data Security, LLC (“Ginkgo Data Security,” “we,” “us,” or “our”) respects your privacy and is committed to protecting the information you provide when visiting our website.

This Privacy Policy explains what information we collect through our website, how we use it, and the limited circumstances under which it may be shared. Our website is designed to collect only the minimum information necessary to operate the site and respond to inquiries.

1. Scope of This Policy

This Privacy Policy applies to information collected through the website operated by Ginkgo Data Security, LLC.

Automatically Collected Technical Information

Like most websites, certain technical information may be automatically collected by our hosting infrastructure and security systems when you visit the site. This may include:

- IP address

- Browser type and version

- Device type

Pages visited
Date and time of access
Referring website or link

This information is used only to operate, maintain, and secure the website, and for basic website performance analysis.

3. Cookies and Website Technologies

Our website may use cookies or similar technologies necessary for website functionality, performance monitoring, and security. Cookies are small text files stored on your device that help websites operate efficiently. We do not use cookies for behavioral advertising or cross-site tracking. You may configure your browser to refuse cookies; however, some website functionality may be affected.

4. How We Use Information

Information collected through the website may be used to:

- Respond to inquiries or communications
- Provide information about our services when requested
- Maintain and improve the website
- Monitor website performance and security
- Detect or prevent malicious activity or misuse of the site

We use collected information only for legitimate business and operational purposes.

5. Data Sharing and Disclosure

Ginkgo Data Security does not sell, rent, or trade personal information. We do not share personal information with third parties for marketing or advertising purposes. Information may be shared only in the following limited circumstances:

Service Providers

We may use trusted third-party service providers to operate our website or supporting infrastructure, such as:
